

Institutional Student Surveys

The following campus surveys are considered institutional surveys that are used to guide institutional decision making, accreditation efforts, and strategic planning and thus take priority. These surveys are conducted on a regular basis, administered to students in various college/programs/units, the results are shared campus-wide, and the findings are used by various campus committees, colleges, and units.

- [Chancellors Senior Survey \(CSS\)](#) – Managed by the Provost’s Office, this survey is administered to all graduating seniors in November and March.
- National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE) – Managed by the Provost’s Office, this survey is administered to all seniors and first year students in March, typically every three years.
- [Illini Success \(IS\)](#) – Managed by the Career Center, this survey is administered to all graduating seniors in December and April.
- [Multi-Institutional Study of Leadership \(MSL\)](#) – Managed by Student Affairs, this study is administered to a random sample of undergraduate students and student involved in various co-curricular programs across campus. The study is conducted every three years in February.
- [Campus Sexual Misconduct Survey/Campus Climate \(CSM/CC\)](#)– Managed by Student Affairs and supported by the Chancellors Office this survey is administered every 4 years in February.
- [American College Health Assessment \(ACHA\)](#) – Managed Student Affairs and the McKinley Health Center, this survey is sent to random sample of all students every 3 years in February.
- Campus Climate Survey (CCS)– Managed by the Office of the Vice Chancellor for Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion. This survey is currently being designed for implementation and will be added to the calendar once finalized.
- [Student Experience Survey \(SES\)](#) – Managed by Student Affairs, this survey is sent to a random sample of all students who are not graduating during that semester.
- [AAUDE Doctoral Exit Survey](#) – Managed by the Graduate College, this survey is sent to all doctoral students after submitting their dissertation.

Due to the wide-spread use of this data, institutional surveys have been approved for large sample sizes (above 5,000) or full-population studies.
